FUNDRAISING IDEAS FOR SCHOOLS

Getting your community involved can really boost fundraising efforts and help spread the word about Variety and Hair with Heart. There are lots of ways your workplace, school, sporting club, family and friends can support your big chop. Here are some of our favourites!



WEAR RED DAY

A classic! Make sure you ask for a gold coin donation to go towards your fundraising efforts. You could host a morning tea on the day as well!



BAKE SALE

An oldie but a goodie – everybody loves a good cupcake or cookie! Be as creative as you like, what about red icing or heart shapes?!



AUCTION OFF THE CHOP

Raise some extra funds and have a bit of fun on the day by holding an auction for who gets to chop off those ponytails!



CRAZY HAIR DAY

A great way to get the community involved and raise awareness for those who have lost their hair due to a medical condition.

Fundraising Materials

Variety's Name and Logo

It's really, really important when it comes to your flyers, posters and social media posts that you promote your fundraising event as "Supporting Variety – the Children's Charity" and use our Variety logo. Cash Donations

We encourage using your online fundraising page as much as possible, including banking the cash donations you receive through your page. If somebody needs a receipt you can enter their donation on their behalf through your page.

SPREAD THE WORD

So ... now what? It's time to share with the world, starting with your nearest and dearest.

Emails and Phone Calls

People can be a little shy when it comes to being the first to donate so start by asking the students to contact their closest friends and family to get the ball rolling – they're your biggest supporters!

Here's an email template we've put together to help get you started. Remember to add a few personal details too! The more unique to you, the more likely they'll be to donate.

Local Community and Businesses

Print off some fundraising posters and ask local businesses and community services, like your library or town hall, to post on their community boards or in their windows. This is a great way to spread the word about your efforts as well as Variety and Hair with Heart.

Local Newspapers and Radio

Community media are often very supportive of hair donors, so why not tell them about your efforts. Not sure what to say? No worries, our PR Manager prepared a media release template for you. Simply add in your schools' details and send it off to your local papers, radio, etc (best place to look for their news desk or story submissions is via their websites).

Here are our top social media tips we've learnt from our fundraisers:

- Tag your friends who have donated to say "thanks"
- Use the share buttons on your online fundraising page
- Use images with your posts (we've made some to get you started)
- Be personal, include why you're donating your hair it means much more to people!
- Tag @VarietyAustralia and use the hashtags #HairwithHeart #VarietyAustralia
