Get ready to raise funds online


Setting up a Hair with Heart online fundraising page is quick and easy. We'd love to work with you to tailor a page to your needs.

Start off by completing the registration form to create your individual page. You will have the option to create a team page, aka your 'Chop Squad'.

Visit the My Team tab on your dashboard to find your invite link. Invite students and staff to join you via your team page link.

Event ideas for your school

Schools around Australia have hosted inspiring, memorable events – from primary to high school! Here are a few ways to build excitement, spread the word about Hair with Heart, and raise funds for kids in need:

WEAR RED DAY

A classic! Get students to wear red casual clothes to school for one day only and bring in a gold coin donation. Feeling ambitious? You could also organise a morning tea, walk or fun run.

BAKE SALE

Who doesn't love a tasty cupcake or cookie? Especially knowing that each bite can help provide opportunities to kids in need! Get as creative as you like (red icing and heart shapes anyone?).

AUCTION OFF THE CHOP

Raise some extra funds, and have some extra fun, by holding an auction. Who will get to be the one holding the scissors on the day to chop the ponytails?

CRAZY HAIR DAY

This is a great way to get your whole school involved. Instead of (or as well as) a 'Wear Red Day,' get students and staff in crazy hairdos to raise awareness for those who have lost their hair due to a medical condition.

GROUP CHOP

If there are a few students and staff taking the chop this year, get them together and organise one big event, with opportunities for extra donations!

ENCOURAGE YOUR SCHOOL COMMUNITY

We recommend that you chat with the person in charge of your school's newsletter and/or social media. Share your school's media release and encourage any students – whether they're chopping or not – to message their friends and family with a link to the school fundraising page! Share the date of your chop in assembly – and make sure everyone knows of any fundraisers you will be holding, and when!



LOCAL COMMUNITY AND BUSINESS

Local businesses love supporting school fundraising events, especially for such a great cause. Print off some fundraising posters, send a few quick emails to local businesses, and check if they'd be ok to put them up in public spaces. It's a great way to spread the word! GO VIRAL – NEWSPAPERS AND RADIO

We've put together a media release template you can share with your local media outlets, who are also often very supportive of Hair Heroes donors! Just add in your school's details and send them off to any local papers, radio, or even TV stations. Check their websites to look for news desk or story submissions to get in touch.



Once you've got the ball rolling, you can start sharing your efforts further – social media is a great tool for this!

Tips from some of our best fundraisers...

We asked the Hair with Heart community to share their best advice for schools with an online fundraising page. Here's what they had to say:

THERE'S LOTS OF WAYS TO FUNDRAISE

"Use different channels – online fundraising page, face-to-face donations, raffles, events – so you can capture the widest possible donor audience. Most importantly, tell the story of why you're fundraising."

TIME OF DAY AND WEEK

"The time of day made a huge impact on the support I received. I found the most successful time where I had the most support was a Sunday evening. It may not all have been for donations, but I received a lot of support at this time."

SAY THANK YOU

"It's important to make people aware that support is not just financial. Making people aware of Variety and the work they do is just as important.

Make sure to say a big THANK YOU to anyone who donates to your school's page."

ONE TO ONE

"One big Facebook post can do the trick, but I found it may be better to directly message people about your fundraising."
