Dear Friend,

My name's Hannah and I'm 15 years old. I started getting bald patches in my hair when I was 4 years old and when I was 5, I was diagnosed with Alopecia Areata. Alopecia Areata is a lifelong condition where your immune system attacks your hair follicles, causing the hair to fall out.

Something I have found hard is being called names or being teased at school. Mostly everyone is nice, but some kids don't understand my condition and I don't always like to stand out.

Thanks to Variety I have received two wigs that I really love – they helped rebuild my confidence, so I felt happy again playing netball and being on stage either dancing, singing or acting.

Thank you so much for joining the Hair with Heart movement, you're making a real impact! We've put together this pack to help you make the most of your big chop.

You'll find the **Hair Hero guidebook**, which is packed with fundraising tips from other Hair with Heart fundraisers PLUS *The Journey of Your Hair* – an explainer on just where it is your donated hair and the funds you raise through your big chop will go. # You're our Hair Hero! We'd love to share a story to get things started.

It's called: The Journey Of Your Hair.

It all started when you made the big-hearted decision to help someone facing hair loss due to a medical condition by donating your hair and fundraising through Hair with Heart.

Right now, there is a person with alopecia, cancer, or another medical condition waiting to receive their very own custommade wig. This wig has the power to help renew their sense of happiness and confidence – and it could have some of YOUR very own hair in it!

The next big step is the **Big Chop:** the day that you cut off your locks and send them through to Variety's Hair with Heart HQ.

From there, your hair will be sent on its way to become a part of a specialised wig – it's like magic!

#### But there's a plot twist...

You might think that your hair donation can only help one person – but that's not true at all!







In fact, your hair has the power to change more than one life. It helps in three ways:

- 1. When we receive your hair, our wonderful volunteers unpack, sort and send it to the wigmaker. Variety raises money from these donations, which in turn help fund our incredible range of programs and grants that support kids who are sick, living with a disability or experiencing disadvantage.
- 2. By donating your hair and fundraising for Variety, you're also helping to supply wigs to kids who have lost their hair due to a medical condition through our wig grant. Did you know it takes 10-20 ponytails to make just one wig, or that a specialised wig can cost up to \$6,000? Not only is your generosity helping to provide a wig to a kid that needs it you're also alleviating financial pressure for their family too.
- 3. Finally, your hair journey helps by inspiring your friends, family and local community to support your chop and donate through your Hair with Heart fundraising page. The funds you raise go directly towards Variety's grants and programs, so your big chop goes so much further than you might think: you are changing the lives of children by giving the help that no-one else is able to give.

# Hannah's Story: Walking into High School with CONFIDENCE

You heard from Hannah Hodge in the letter with this pack, but I would like to share more of Hannah's story with you.

Hannah's mum Christine described her as "outgoing, someone who loved to sing, play, and hang out" – but throughout primary school, Hannah's hair loss was taking its toll.

"It was far from easy," Christine said.

"Hannah's confidence levels were dwindling and our bright and vivacious little girl was disappearing under the weight of her alopecia."

As Hannah got older, the thought of going to high school was really scary.

How could Hannah face the challenges of high school with confidence and happiness?

Hannah said that having the wig made a world of difference.

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# How to chop guide

#### **CUTTING YOUR HAIR:**

#### When cutting your hair:

- 1. Your hair should be clean and dry
- 2. Tie hair in multiple pony tails. You can use the hair ties provided in this pack!
- 3. Plait each pony tail and secure each end with a hair tie.
- 4. Cut above the top hair ties.

#### **SENDING YOUR HAIR:**

- Complete the online form: variety.org.au/hair-donation-form/
- 2. Put your hair into a Ziploc bag
- 3. Post your hair and the printed form to: Variety - The Children's Charity Locked Bag 2468 St Leonards NSW 1590

#### **HOW YOUR HAIR WILL BE USED:**



If your hair is >35cm and not chemically straightened or coloured, it can be used to create a specialised suction wig for people who have lost their hair due to a medical condition. Long, natural wigs like these are especially popular with children and will be cared for and cherished for years to come.

If your hair is <35cm and/or coloured, it can still be part of a beautiful wig! Wigmakers can work with shorter and coloured ponytails to craft stylish wigs that adults in particular love.
